

STC'S COVID AND ILLNESS POLICY

Masks

At this time, wearing a mask while inside Story Theater Company's facility is optional. Mask-wearing for performances will be subject to the performance location's requirements.

Illness Policy

Participants (students and staff) will be expected to stay home if:

- Any participant is exhibiting symptoms of illness, such as cough, fever, or shortness of breath.
- Any participant has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or has a suspected diagnosis of COVID-19.

Exposure

Any participant who has a diagnosis or suspected diagnosis of COVID-19 will be expected to notify Story Theater Company immediately. Parents will be responsible for informing the appropriate STC staff member associated with the event the child is involved in:

- If your child is involved in a show, contact our Production Manager at productions@storytheatercompany.org
- If your child is involved in a workshop or club, contact our Education Director at education@storytheatercompany.org

Parents will be notified via email if there has been a COVID positive case at an event their child participated in.

Changes to Mitigation Protocols

If community COVID conditions change, Story Theater Company may choose to alter some of its COVID guidelines. Any change in protocol will be clearly communicated to participants before the change goes into effect.
